

- ① Most courses in the Undergraduate Program are conducted in Korean, but some classes are taught in English. (Please check with the department office whether English classes are available.)
- ② Applicants who apply for the Undergraduate Freshman Program can select two departments, with a First Preference and Second Preference, but students in a department marked in bold can apply for their Second Preference only. (The Second Preference is not available for those who apply for the Undergraduate Transfer Program.)
- 3 School of Architecture (Major in Architecture) is a 5-year program.
- ④ Students who are enrolled in the Department of Civil Engineering, Electrical Engineering, or Agricultural Civil & Bio-industrial Engineering must complete the ABEEK (Accreditation Board for Engineering Education of Korea) program. Transfer students may take one or two semesters longer depending on their ABEEK requirements.
- (5) Applicants for the Department of Korean Literature in Classical Chinese, French Language & Literature, and Media and Communication must attend an in-person interview with a department representative in Korea.
- 6 The Departments of Music, Design, and Fine Arts accept new students in the spring semester only.
- ② According to the Regulations for Student Enrollment at the College of Education, the acceptance rate of international students cannot exceed 10% of the admission quota, and Transfer Program applicants will not be eligible to apply (Freshmen Program only).
- ® Applicants for the Department of Music must complete a Performance Test.

4 Eligibility

< Nationality Requirement for both Freshmen and Transfer Students >

- · Applicants and both of their parents must be non-Korean nationals.
 - * Nationality criterion is evidenced only if applicants and both of their parents acquire non-Korean nationality by the time the applicant begins the curriculum corresponding to the educational programs of Korean high schools.
- Multi-nationals with Korean citizenship are not eligible.
- Eligible Nationality Status must be established before the application due date.

1. Freshmen Admissions

- ▶ Applicants must meet all of the following requirements:
- ① He or she must have completed his or her entire elementary and junior high school education and;
- ② He or she must have completed (or is expected to complete) high school education at a comparable and equivalent level to that which is provided in Korea.

% NOTE:

 Applicants who have completed home schooling, cyber learning, or taken qualification exams in Korea or abroad during their 12 years of primary education are NOT eligible for enrollment.

- O Applicants should complete all formal education in ONE country.
- Applicants who have studied in more than 2 countries should complete 12 years of education.
 - Applicants who have completed less than 11 years should apply for high school as a freshman or transfer within Korea or overseas.
 - In the case of 11-year foreign systems (see chart above), applicants should complete the last 3 years of education in ONE country in order to acquire high school qualification.
 - For students with unfinished years due to a gap in their education system, the period of years at an overseas university will be counted as equivalent to Korean high school years.

☐ Criteria for Qualification of High School Graduation

O High school graduation should be completed by the day prior to the opening day of admission to KNU in order to qualify. However, for applicants from countries in which the academic year and the opening day of school differ by more than one (1) month from Korea (e.g., Japan), one (1) full month of attendance at an overseas high school will be approved as equivalent to graduation.

2. Transfer Admissions (3rd Year)

- ▶ Applicants must meet either of the following requirements:
- ① Graduated or about to graduate from a 4-year university, or;
- ② Graduated or about to graduate from a 2 or 3-year accredited college or completed at least two years (4 semesters) of a 4-year university program (completed over 65 credit hours).

*** NOTE:**

- Those who have completed two years at a 3-year university are not eligible.
- Those who graduated from a university that does not have a credit system are not eligible.
- Those who are enrolled at KNU cannot apply for transfer admission.
- Applicants who have completed home schooling, cyber learning, or taken qualification exams in Korea or abroad during their entire education period are NOT eligible for enrollment.

3. Eligibility for Language Proficiency

- A. Applicants who want to apply for the following 14 Departments must submit a Korean Language Score Report by Dec. 16th (Fri), 2022.
 - ** However, those who take the 84th [Oct. 16th (Sun)] or 85th [Nov. 13th (Sun)] TOPIK exam can apply with their Test Identification Slip and must submit a TOPIK Certificate for Level 3 or 4 (or higher) by Dec. 16th (Fri.), 1:00pm, 2022.


- ** Applicants who take the 84th [Oct. 16th (Sun)] or 85th [Nov. 13th (Sun)] TOPIK exam can apply with a Test Identification Slip and must submit a Certificate for Level 3 (or higher) by Dec. 16th, 1:00pm, 2022.
- ② Korean Proficiency: Certificate of Completion for Level 3 or higher at a university-affiliated Korean Language Institute.
 - X Only accepted if completion date is before Nov. 10th, 2022.
- 3 Applicants who can speak Korean but do not have a certificate of Korean language proficiency can submit an English score report from a recognized English proficiency test (e.g., TOEFL iBT 71, IELTS 5.5, NEW TEPS 326, CEFR B2 or higher).
 - * Only accepted if date of receiving score is before Nov. 10th, 2022.
 - * Applicants do not need to submit an English score report if they are from a country whose official language is English (USA, UK, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Republic of South Africa, Ireland).

5 Application Procedure

1. Applications

- A. Online Application Period: Oct. 17 (Mon) 9:00am, 2022 Nov. 4 (Fri) 6:00pm, 2022
 - ① Online Application Site: To be announced at a later date on the KNU website (http://en.knu.ac.kr).
 - 2 You will receive an Application Number after completing the Online Application.

★ Online Application Process



- ▶ The application will be processed once the Application Fee is paid.
- ▶ Modifications and cancellations are not allowed after completing the online application.
- ▶ If the applicant cancels their online application before Nov. 4th, 6:00pm, the Application Fee will be refunded 100%. After the application deadline, the Application Fee cannot be refunded.
- ▶ After completing the online application, you must print out a Test Identification Slip and make note of the Application Number (5 digits) for future reference.
- ▶ Applicants who fail to submit all required documents by the specified date (Nov. 10th, 2022) will be excluded from the screening process, even if their online application is completed.
- ▶ Please complete your application in advance to avoid a system overload or other issues on the last day of the application period.

- B. How to Interview: In-person interview or online interview (e.g., ZOOM) with the respective department.

 - ② Applicants who are not selected for their first department preference will be interviewed for their second preference.

The final Certificate of Graduation and Verification Certificate (Chinese: "Xuexinwang" Certificate; Others: Apostille or Certificate verified by the appropriate embassy) should be submitted by mid-Jan., 2023.
 - Transcripts showing the applicant's final semester must be submitted by Feb. 24th (Fri), 2023.

 - → Submit an original bank certificate of the deposit balance (in English) showing an amount of at least USD \$18,000 in the applicant's name.
 - 2) If the Financial Guarantor is a parent:
 - → Submit an original bank certificate of deposit balance (in English) showing an amount of at least USD \$18,000 in a parent's name.
 - → Employment Certificate or Business Registration Certificate from a parent ※ Brothers and sisters can be guarantors only in cases of the parents' absence.
 - 3 Scholarship Certificate from another organization: If applicants are financially supported from their own countries' government or another organization
 - * If the total amount of scholarship or support funds is less than USD \$18,000, the applicant will need to submit an original bank certificate of deposit balance for the remaining amount, as required per ① or ②.

- 1. Certificates without an expiration date must be issued within one month of submission.

 - ** Note: It is not possible to revise the application contents after the Application Fee has been paid.
- 3. Refunds
 - A. Relevant Applicants: Applicants who did not pass the Qualification Screening
 - B. Refund Amount: ₩20,000 (Korean won currency)
 - C. Refund Method: ₩20,000 will be refunded to the applicant's bank account.
 - ** Note: Applicants who fail the Qualification Screening must submit a copy of their bankbook (Korean bank) in the applicant's name by Nov. 25th (Fri), 2022.
 Only those who do not have a Korean bank account may submit a copy of a friend or relative's bank account. However, overseas remittance is not available.

8 Important Notes for Applicants

- 1. All documents should be in Korean or English. Documents in other languages must be accompanied by a notarized Korean or English translation.
- 2. If any required documents are found to be false or counterfeit, your application will be canceled.
- 3. Notices related to the admissions process will be sent to the applicant's email address entered on the Application Form, so applicants should check their email frequently after submitting their application. The Office of International Affairs is not responsible for application cancellation due to incorrect contact information (email, phone number, etc.), or due to not checking emails.
- 4. If an applicant's visa is not issued, or is rejected, then their application will be canceled.
- 5. Applicants receiving a scholarship of more than USD \$18,000 from another institution are not required to submit a Certificate of Financial Guarantee; however, they must submit a Certificate/Letter of Confirmation from the institution that will pay their tuition during their period of study at KNU.
- 6. No submitted documents will be returned to the applicant. (Note: Original documents will be returned after the screening process is completed.)
- 7. If applicants do not have sufficient academic ability, they may not be selected.
- 8. According to the regulations for Recognition of Graduation Qualification at KNU, international undergraduate students (excluding transfer students) who are enrolled at KNU must have a "TOPIK" certificate for Level 4 or higher before graduation.
- 9. International students who are admitted to, or already enrolled at, KNU must have Korean health insurance. According to the National Health Insurance Act and its Enforcement Decree, international students who stay in Korea for more than 6 months must have National Health Insurance (국민건강보험) while in Korea.

- 10. Applicants already residing Korea who receive admission from KNU must apply for a Change of Visa Status (D-2-2) before the semester begins (March 2nd, 2023). We strongly recommend checking with the Immigration Office in person to first determine whether it is possible to change one's visa status to D-2-2 in Korea after being admitted to KNU. (Call center of Immigration office: \$\alpha\$1345, without an area code)
- 11. Further details, if not stated in this Guide, will be in accordance with the Office of International Affairs at KNU.
- 12. These Admission Guidelines were originally written in Korean and translated into English, Chinese, Japanese, and Vietnamese. Should there be any discrepancies between them, the Korean version supercedes all translated versions.

9 Scholarships and Benefits

- 1. TOPIK Scholarships for New Students
 - A. TOPIK Level 3 Certificate: Scholarship for 16-20% of the Tuition Fee for the first semester.
 - B. TOPIK Level 4 Certificate: Scholarship for 40-42% of the Tuition Fee for the first semester.
 - C. TOPIK Level 5 Certificate: Scholarship for 80-84% of the Tuition Fee for the first semester.
 - D. TOPIK Level 6 Certificate: Scholarship for 100% of the Tuition Fee for the first semester.

- 2. Scholarships for students who complete 2 semesters of the KNU Korean Language Program (as of Nov. 10th, 2022): Scholarship for 16-20% of the Tuition Fee for the first semester.
 - ** However, note that it is not possible to receive this scholarship together with a TOPIK Scholarship for new students (see 1. above); you can only receive ONE scholarship.
- 3. TOPIK Scholarship for Enrolled Students: Those who do not have a TOPIK Certificate or have a TOPIK Level 3 Certificate when they enter KNU can receive a scholarship after getting a TOPIK Level 4 Certificate or higher.

III APPENDICES

1 Apostille

Since July 14, 2007, the Republic of Korea has been part of the 1961 Hague Convention abolishing the Requirement of Legalization for Foreign Public Documents. The Convention provides for the use of simplified certification of public documents (including notarized documents) among countries that have joined the convention. The Apostille designation ensures that public documents issued in one signatory country will be recognized as valid in another signatory country.

NOTE: Newly admitted students from countries that are signatories to the convention must meet the following requirements:

- ① Official certificates (transcripts, diplomas, etc.) from public schools or institutions should be submitted together with an "Apostille" attachment.
- ② Official certificates (transcripts, diplomas, etc.) from private schools or institutions, however, should be officially notarized by a notary, agency, or any other authority competent under the law of the country of origin of the certificates; then, the certificates should be submitted together with an "Apostille" attachment.
