

[Reference 2] Transcript and Certificate of (Expected) Graduation

A. For overseas school (or university) graduation certificates and transcripts, submit verified documents in one of the following ways. (Except for the official seal of the principal of one of the Korean International Schools authorized by the Minister of Education)

1. Obtaining Apostille stamps on documents (graduation & transcript of high school/university)

- * In cases where the student has attended or graduated from school(s) in a country that is a member of the Hague Convention, see Appendix #3 'Apostille Convention Countries.'
- **2. Obtaining certification of documents** (graduation & transcript of high school/university) from the Korean Embassy or Consular office in the country where the applicant's school is located or from the Embassy of the country where the applicant's school is located in Korea.
- 3. Only for applicants who receive(d) diploma or academic degree from Chinese high school or universities
 - X Verification can be obtained at the website of the China Higher-education Student Information (www.chsi.com.cn). It will take about 3~4 weeks.
- \times Graduates (or graduates-to-be) from secondary vocational schools in China must submit the diploma and translations authenticated by (1) or (2).
- (1) diploma and Translations issued by a school, and authenticated by the province Education Department (省教育厅) and the Korean Embassy
- (2) diploma and Translations issued by the province Education Department (省教育厅) and authenticated by the Korean Embassy

[Reference 3] Certificate of Financial Support and Certificate of Bank Balance

A. Certificate of Bank Balance must be one of the following:

- bank certificate of the balance of USD 18,000 or more in the name of the applicant
- bank certificate of the balance of USD 18,000 or more in the name of the applicant's father
- bank certificate of the balance of USD 18,000 or more in the name of the applicant's mother
- certificate of money transfer to Korea or money exchange (each of the above should be issued within 30 days of the date of submission)
- * If the balance certificate has an expiration date, it is recognized only until the expiration date.

X Only Vietnamese applicants:

- (In Korea) Should submit a certificate of bank balance issued from the branch of NH bank in Pusan National University and deposit the same amount of money by 2023 Jun 23. Additional transaction history of the same account should be submitted after admission.
- (In Overseas) Should submit a certificate of bank balance issued from either SHINHAN or WOORI bank in Vietnam and deposit the same amount of money by 2023 Jun 23. Additional transaction history of the same account should be submitted after admission.

X Only Uzbekistani applicants:

B. Certificate of Financial Support [Form 3]: The holder of the bank balance certificate is the guarantor. The certificate of financial support [Form 3] needs to be submitted with the guarantor's handwritten signature.

4. Selection Method

Document Screening and Interview

Admission will be decided through comprehensive review with document screening and interview (interview only applicable to certain departments).

Document Screening

The Admissions Committee reviews the submitted documents such as Personal Statement, Study Plan, transcripts, etc.

X Those who apply to a department that reviews only with document screening will be notified by that department that there will be no interview.

Interview

- 1) Applicant in Korea: Face-to-face interview (will be conducted at each department's designated location)
- 2) Applicant overseas: Phone or Zoom interview

NOTE on Interviews

- 1) The applicant in Korea must arrive at the designated location with the test identification slip and an ID card (passport, Alien Registration Card, and other documents) on the day of the interview.
- 2) In principle, the applicant overseas should have an interview via phone or video conference, so it is important to write your exact phone number for the phone interview.


